Attention was paid in fact on the presentation of these two preliminary documents in order to have feedbacks and ideas coming from external experts about AAL in the future. The work was done both on scenarios and Key Enabling Technologies (KETs) because, as emerged also from the workshop, it is important to find some key scenarios to focus on to then give the right recommendations about the future technology development.

Participants

The workshop was attended by **22 experts coming from different frameworks**, i.e. research organizations, service provider and industries. Their participation was very useful for future improvement of the AALIANCE2 Roadmap and Strategic Research Agenda.

Sessions

The workshop was made of **four sessions**:

1. Ideas sharing (Plenary)
2. Revision of key components of Roadmap and SRA - Part1(Parallel Group)
3. Revision of key components of Roadmap and SRA - Part2(Parallel Group)
4. Recommendations and other considerations

The attendees received some preliminary documents, i.e. the description of pillars and scenarios and the description of the KETs with the prioritization, in order to be prepared to the activities of the workshop.

During these sessions several interesting considerations were expressed about the work done until now on the Roadmap and SRA, thus providing novel and interesting input for the further development of the two documents.

Enlargement of the AALIANCE2 Network

Three exhibition booths were taken in Norrköping (Sweden) during the **AAL Forum**, Ancona (Italy) during the **foritaal Forum**, and Vilnius (Lithuanian) during the **ICT2013** event in order to enlarge the AALIANCE2 Network and make questionnaires to the participants. In particular it was asked to the people to answer three questions in order to have ideas and recommendations coming from the different stakeholders.

Each people indicated, choosing among four groups, in which category of stakeholder was included and replied to a series of questions about barriers to overcome in the AAL market, good practices and the role of technology.
